We are excited to share our story along with our annual report. Together We Inspire Neighborhood Superstars 501(c3) non-profit was established on 5/27/20 to support a local boxing club that my three sons where attending. Covid-19 shut down on 3/19/20 caused everything to come to a hualt. My sons continued to train in our garage on their own. Our call to our old boxing friends came when we started to notice a lot of youth out in the streets. With structured schedules we managed to maintain small group workouts with the support of our Oxnard P.D. Without realizing that other cities with higher income revenue never stopped playing. Causing us to notice the inequity due to our area code.

Covid-19 mandatory orders lifted on 1/25/21 and we began our efforts to fund and search for our building. July 2022 we move our club into a building and by November we where in a bigger building. At the end of 2022 we had grown into a 100 member club. With the generosity of our funders, donors and our fundraising; we have provided a safe place with equipment for youth to come and learn a sport at no cost.

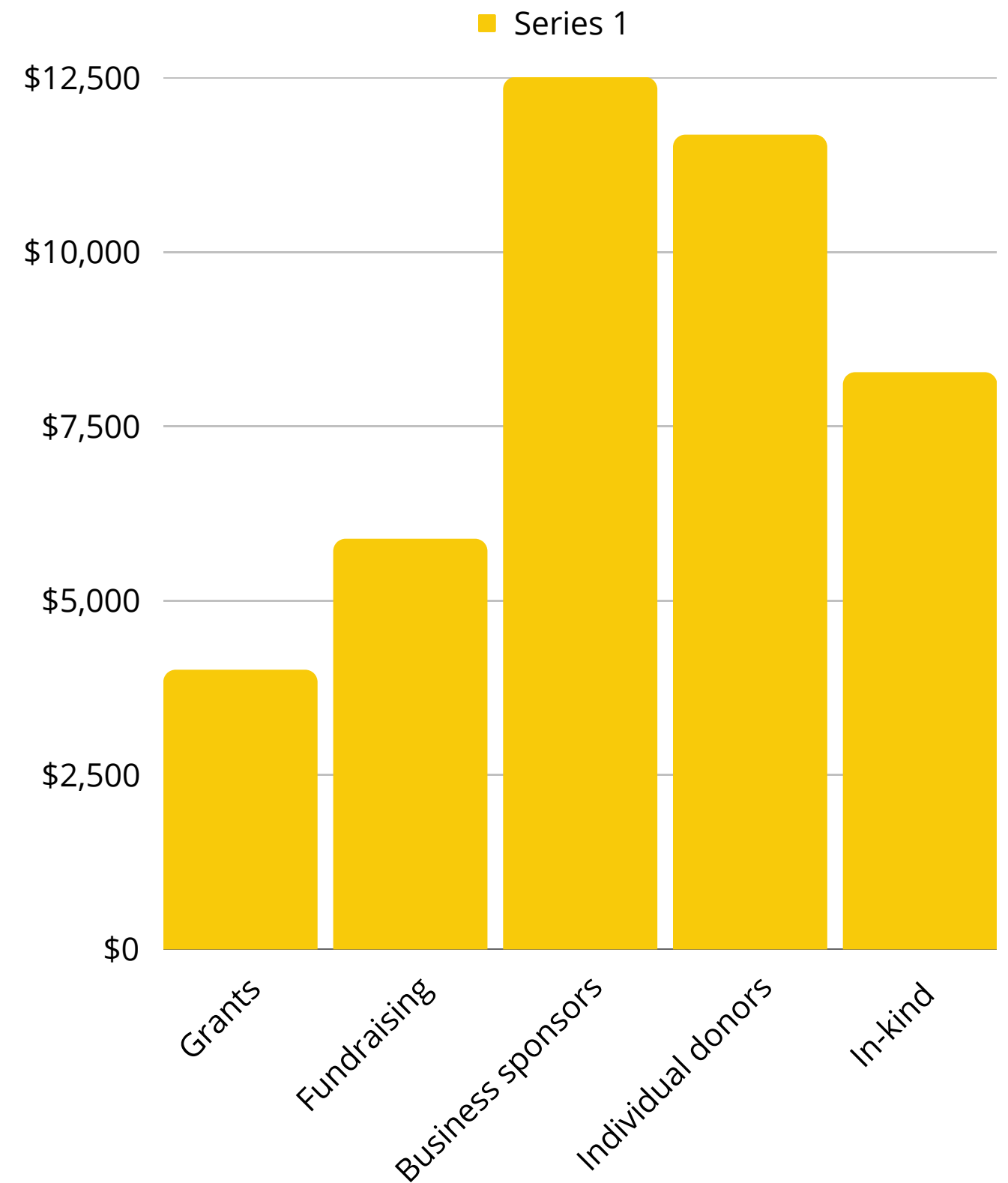
Our boardmembers and club volunteers are dedicated to working to ensure our youth stays active in sport so they may reap the benefits sports can provide as an individual.

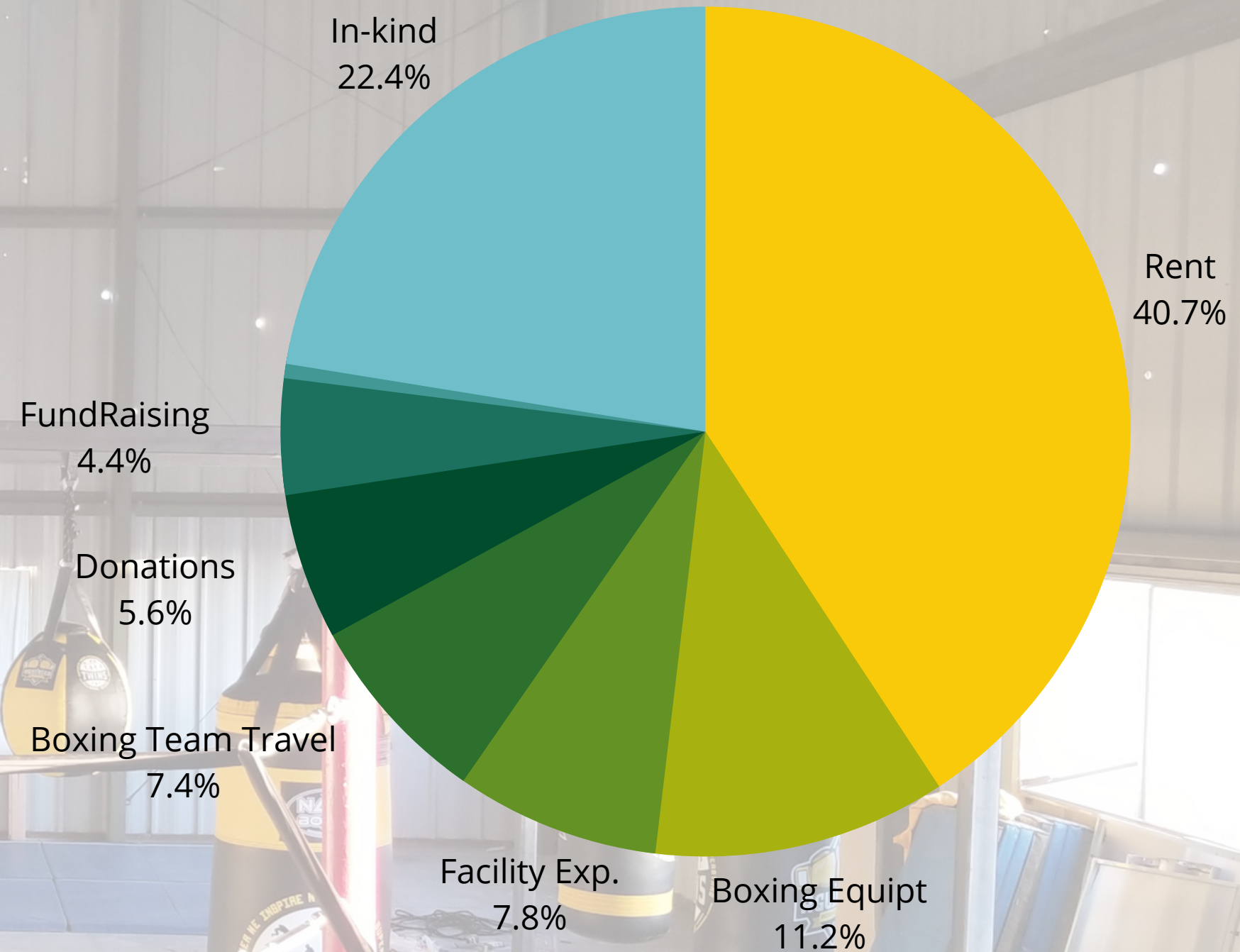


Total funds raised 2022

- Board meeting

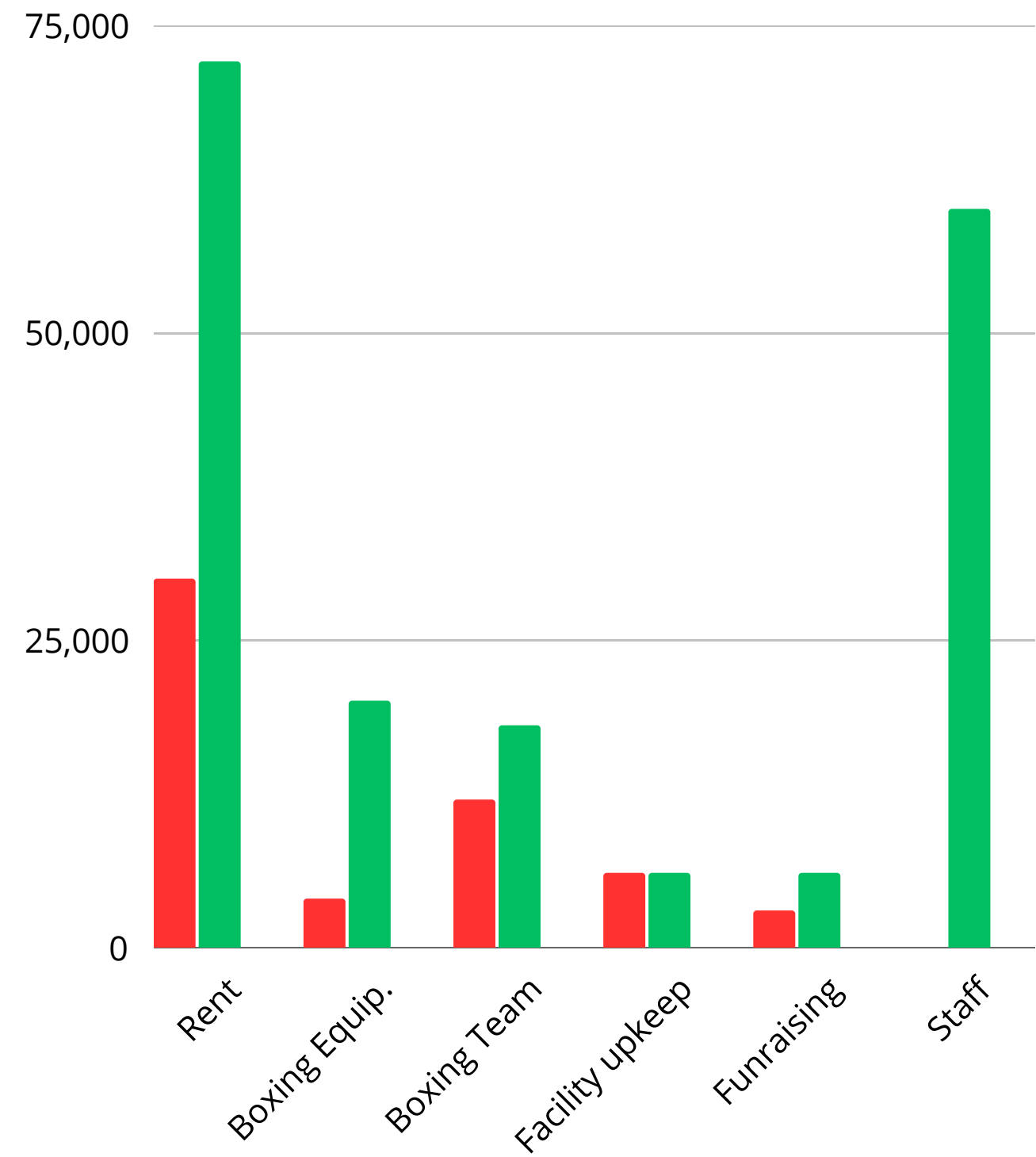


Challenges & Goals for 2023
